Become a digital nomad in Portugal

With this, you won't have any tax to pay on foreign income, and if you register as a freelancer in Portugal, you'll only pay 20% tax on income earned in Portugal (compared to the standard 48%) and won't have to pay social security for the first 12-months.

Don't forget – you'll have to spend a minimum of 183days in Portugal to keep hold of your visa.
